<i>Course Objectives:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understanding basic principles and origins in the area of commercial law, • theoretical and practical preparation enabling students to acquire knowledge and skills related to commercial law.
<i>Learning outcomes</i> <i>On successful completion of this course, student should be able to:</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. define basic terms, values and laws in the area of commercial law, 2. describe methods of applying principles and provisions of commercial law, 3. compose simple contracts, 4. assess the correctness of applying specific laws to a specific cases and choosing the most appropriate one
<i>Course content</i>	Introduction. Property law. Definition of Commercial law; Origins of Commercial Law. Definition and forms of obligation. Penalty, earnest payment, guarantee. Transfer of a personal right between creditors or debtors (cession, assignation, guarantee) Restitution, statute of limitations. Contract of sale. Lease agreement. Timeshare agreement, Agency agreement, Shipping agreement, Commission agreement, License agreement. Securities (Promissory note and cheque).
